Armored B6 Volvo 960 Royal Limousine Official service registration number BFJ 650 -

a unique executive vehicle, custom-built by special order of the Swedish government and used by the Swedish Security Service to escort foreign heads of state, emperors, and members of royal families between 1997-2005.

- it took part in 15+ of the most significant official and state visits.
- it transported leaders from Europe, Asia, the Middle East, Africa, and Latin America – from Nelson Mandela to Emperor Akihito, from Jacques Chirac to King Abdullah II.

PRICELESS HISTORY OF THE SERVICE


The last classic Volvo limousine -

hand-built in an era of different standards, the last Volvo model to feature rear-wheel drive. It is massive, with strict angular lines, monumental, featuring an extended wheelbase by 80 cm, wellprotected, and equipped with a B6-level armored passenger capsule.









CREATION HISTORY

In the mid-1990s, the Swedish government set out to update its official state car, intended for meetings with heads of state, official delegations, and special guests of the Kingdom.

The project was handled by the Swedish Security Service, and the Volvo 964-956 was chosen as the platform.

At that time, it was the flagship of the Swedish automotive industry—a symbol of reliability, safety, and quality.

This was not just an elongated car—it was a unique vehicle, hand-built to the highest standards.

DESIGN

FEATURES VOLVO 960 ROYAL (B6)

- > extended body by 80 cm
- > reinforced structural frame
- specially manufactured and installed glass
- B6-level armored capsule providing the highest protection for passengers

- built-in internal intercom between passenger and driver
- > rear panel for communication and climate control
- > special state communication systems
- > emergency escape hatch, integrated into the structure
- > additional cabin heater

- hidden flashing lights installed both at the front and rear
- > siren and loudspeaker system installed
- white lights installed in the rear bumper, used for security illumination
- > fire detection sensors installed
- > flagpoles installed

COLOR AND STYLE

Scandinavian Diplomatic Tradition

The car was painted in the traditional dark blue diplomatic color, typical for Sweden and Japan in the late 20th century.

This was no coincidence: blue was considered the most "neutral" and "royal" shade. It is well-suited for official visits, as it conveys calmness, formality, and protocol compliance.

The interior follows the characteristic Scandinavian approach:

- > restrained, thoughtful, without excessive luxury
- > no bars, televisions, or gilding
 Only what is necessary for diplomacy: space, comfort, safety, and impeccable ergonomics.

CEREMONY AND PROTOCOL

This is a living artifact of its era, a monument to Scandinavian engineering, diplomacy, and state protocol from the late 20th to early 21st century.

Today, it remains one of the rarest Volvos ever created in the brand's history.



The armored Volvo 960 Royal became the last classic "square" Volvo limousine, hand-built according to the old state standards, when:

- > the factory was located in Sweden
- > production was directly controlled by Volvo
- > special cars were crafted individually, as top-tier creations; quality was prioritized over speed and cost.

SWEDISH DIPLOMATIC PROTOCOL

Sweden ranks among the world leaders in state protocol. During visits by heads of state, SÄPO operated according to standards similar to those of the USA, the UK, and France.

The armored Volvo 960 Royal BFJ 650 was a central part of these events, escorting world-class guests.

BFJ 650 was the only SÄPO vehicle suitable for monarchs and G7 leaders.
